VISION

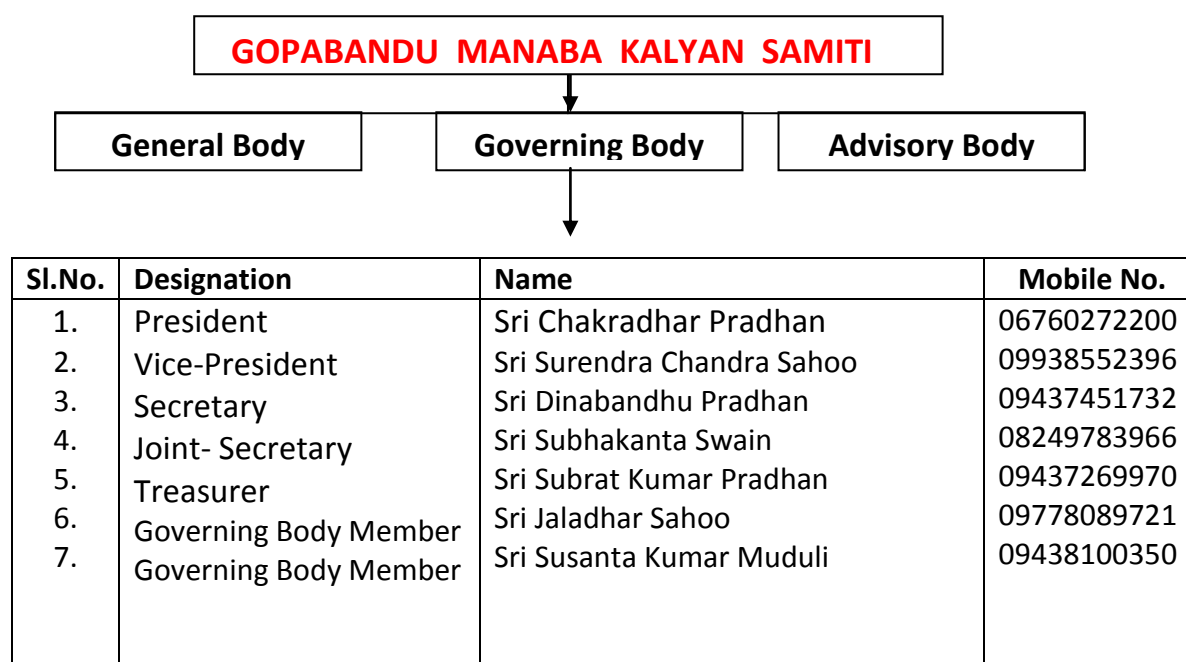
